### **Welcome and Approval of June 2019 Meeting Minutes**

Connie called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m. Steve Hammond made the motion to accept the April/May minutes; 2nd by Jenny Platt; motion carried; minutes approved.

#### INTRODUCTION of our NEW Band Director Mr. Joe Santanello

Mr. Santanello spoke about the benefits and opportunities of being a marching band member. He shared his background information (Quakertown HS). Mr. Santanello informed us that almost all of the prior year staff would be returning for another year. Took time to answer questions from parents and shared his open door/email policy with parents.

Highlighted requirements for a successful June and August band camps: water, hat, sunscreen, bug spray and worn sneakers. In August, students will be provided a dinner and to inform staff of any dietary restrictions.

Shared Knight of Sound event - scheduled for Sep. 14

This will be North Penn's home show and will require numerous volunteers (concession stand, escorts, etc.). More information to follow.

Also announced Disney Trip 2020 4/6-4/11 pending board approval. This trip is for NPMK, Jazz Bands, Concert Band, Chambers Choir and Orchestra. Cost estimated at \$1,500/student. Details to follow in a separate Disney trip meeting.
