Welcome and Approval of June and July 2019 General Parent Meeting Minutes

Karen called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m. Stephen Hammond motioned to approve the June and July meeting minutes; 2nd by Michaeline Neu; motioned carried; meeting minutes approved.

Director Update - Mr. Santanello

First week of band camp was outstanding. Today's heat and sun has been the worst of the 5 days. Mr. Santanello requested parents to speak with their child about drinking water and eating food prior to each day's band camp. Tomorrow will be more of the same and staff is watching out for students and have scheduled multiple breaks each hour. To support students shade tents were set up today and additional water will be available in the tents.

Mr. Santanello laid out expectations for the first 2 home football games. Students are to report at 11:00 on Friday, August 23rd for pictures and remain on school property for rehearsal and football game. He stressed that students should not be leaving the school for meals.

Football game expectations: Band performing CHEESE show, no uniforms, black NP shirts, new shirts have not come in, need veterans to share extra shirts with new members, color guard will be fitted in black velvets, bottom to wear khaki - light tan, brown shorts, dinkles and ankle socks (white). These early football games provide an opportunity to break in new shoes (gain experience marching).

Goal is to debut new uniforms at Sept 14th Knight of Sound. Reminded parents of new custom uniform format. Did design a custom uniform top and the blue pants with a graduated leg wrap. Target delivery is Sept 10th. Traditional uniform for parades. When we are wearing default uniform, will use the helmet. Director was not aware of guard uniform delivery timing.

Amount of parent involvement in band camp is impressive, Mr. Santanello thankful of parental support and thanked attending parents for their patience.

Disney trip received school board approval. Goal now is to ensure all performing groups either have an experience or performance.

Elected Chairpersons Summary Reports (As Applicable)

- Quartermaster Rob Johannesen/Hope Heck Team received some directions, props will be built similar to 2 years ago but bigger. Plan requires 7 total, buying a frame as we only have 6. Show also requires performance pedestals - 3 different heights for students to stand on.
- Knight of Sound Require rental equipment: 2 night towers, will use 1 from the football team. A separate SignUp genius will be sent out to parents.
- Refreshments (Concessions) Stephen Hammond Wednesday is the Costco pick up. SignUp genius released to solicit volunteers. Looking for concessions to be a major fundraiser. Pizza now coming from Boston Style (NP alum).

Sewing / Uniforms - Katy Joyce/Rose Durkin

- Ideas are being discussed for uniforms and flag designs. Possible giant flag to cover the field or giant swing flags for an avalanche effect.
- Leg attachments for the musicians so they look like they have hiking boots on. The fabric will be dyed to match the blue in the uniforms fading to white.
- o Color Guard tracksuits for new members will be ordered before September. The one they have now is discontinued, there is one very similar that will be ordered. The logo on the back and color of the suit will be the same. No new velvets this year. Will have to organize the fittings for picture day.
- First of the flags to be out on the field next week, does not know the number of additional flag. Talked about a giant flag, being ordered, avalanche effect, approached about leg attachments. Do not have a date for color guard uniforms. Picture retakes scheduled for Sept 27th. Fitting them into velvets for the new guard members, should be good for picture day. Rose mentioned that there is guard material upstairs in storage.

Uniforms- Rose Durkin

- All students have been fitted and have a uniform. Gloves were ordered and distributed. They are white this year - ordered extras.
- Students were instructed to get both white and blue socks. They will wear white socks for competitions and blue socks for picture day and parades.
- The dinkles rep will not be able to visit us. All dinkles are ordered for students that need them and the balance was distributed Thursday. I'm waiting for a return authorization to return exchanges.
- All students should have a uniform. Need to build in an opportunity to fit students with dinkles prior to ordering. Having to do a third exchange. Battery and pit require white wristies - Rose will handle and reimburse after the fact. Not time sensitive.
- New shirt order (practice vs new order) bit of a mess. Spiritwear kids already allotted a show shirt, (short sleeves) be mindful that in the spiritwear website if you



order additional show shirts - send email to npma student financials to get a listing of your registration order form.
