

NPMA General Parent Meeting Minutes Monday, July 20, 2020 **Telecommunication via Zoom**

Welcome and Approval of June 2020 General Parent Meeting Minutes

Annemarie Thornton called the meeting to order at 6:36 pm. Stephen Hammond moved to accept the June General Parent Meeting minutes; 2nd by Christy Johannesson. Motion carried. Minutes approved.

Mr. Santanello

- The MK are approved to move to phase 2 next week. Unfortunately, the use of indoor space is on hold for now. There will be the ability to combine into larger groups of 35 or less - this will happen a few times during practice but will only happen on occasion when necessary.
- The MK are learning the football show, basic drill, playing pop tunes & some music for the show, at this point; getting more music soon.
- There is a request for parents to fill out Covid-19 form for your student before every rehearsal until further notice. If it is not completed, temperatures of students will be taken on arrival to ensure everyone is healthy & stays that way.
- There is no further information about the fall at this point; there is no more information about football, busing, competitions. If necessary, the band will be ready for virtual competition.
- If parents choose the hybrid optional for students, there is no information on whether the student can be in band or not; decisions are still being made depending on the number of students doing which optional. Waiting for further decisions by the school
- Fill out the Absence Form for your student, as appropriate (different than Covid-19
- There will be dinner breaks for rehearsals that are 3pm 9pm, students **MUST** stay on campus. Dinner break will be from 5-5:45. Students need to bring their own dinner to rehearsals or parents can drop off food at 5. Students cannot leave campus during rehearsals in the interest of safety & accountability.
- On Fridays of football games, rehearsal begins at 3:30. From the end of the school day until rehearsal begins at 3:30, students can do whatever is approved of by their parents, i.e. leaving the campus.
- If students are totally virtual, they can still do extra curricular activities. As far as in class band, the belief is that the opportunity will be virtual of some type. But, the student may not be able to attend the holiday or spring concerts. That is speculation since there is still more to be determined. There is uncertainty of hybrid participation in band. There is encouragement to ask the administrators since the experience is uncertain at this time. The administration is listening!
- The uniform fittings need to be worked out yet. A discussion needs to occur with the administration before there is a final decision.
