
- Thank you to all volunteers and donators

Accounts have been reconciled through the month of August. Balances as of August 31, 2021.

- Checking= August Closing Balance \$45,688.32
- SC Market= \$23,414.99
- Holding Money Market= \$5,003.38

Expenses for August -\$18,596

- Scrip, Salaries, High-lift, Props, Band Camp meals, Operating Expenses (Zoom, QuickBooks, web hosting)
- Question raised about level of annual audit required and funds budgeted for effort
 - Audit requirements depend on revenue generated for the organization. Our bi-laws require either an audit committee or a firm to audit annually.
- A significant expense for NPMA is the Audit each year
 - \$6000 budgeted this year for audit
 - According to Bi-laws can have outside auditor or committee
 - State regulations require a "compilation" which is the least rigorous level
 - Do we reinstitute an audit committee and then have an auditor do a compilation which would cost less than the \$6000?
 - This discussion will continue to further meetings
