- Sales Tax Exempt Status successfully renewed!
 - We could request refunds from a handful of companies we paid sales tax to.
 - Parent question about food budget for the snack stand. Can we increase the budget since we run out of things (hot dogs) 3rd guarter? Tori S. and Kenneth F. explained that if we don't run out by then, we end up throwing food away. Patrons typically buy something else if we are sold out of an item. We would rather run out than waste food. We usually have about a 50% profit.

New Business

- Special Election Deb Weed for Uniforms. Motion to vote for Deb as Uniforms chairperson by Andrea H., seconded by Greg H. Unanimous vote yes. Congrats, Deb!

- Knightmares Planning for Nov 2nd.
- Trailer Cleaning / Wrap
 - Our band trailer cosmetically is in terrible shape. It's an embarrassment at competitions.
 - We have a lead to get it wrapped. They recommend we do not attempt to wash it any further so we don't take the finish off and ruin it further.
 - \$4000 estimated to get it wrapped. Not in our budget for this year, so we could vote on it and approve a deficit. Or we could wait until closer to the end of the season.
 - We also didn't budget for a WP home show, so that will generate profit we didn't count on.
 - Parent asked about the life expectancy of the trailer and how long the wrap will last.
 - Greg H. said physically the trailer is in good shape. The truck pulling the trailer is NPSD and not in good shape.
 - NPSD and NPMA split the cost to originally purchase the trailer, so it is titled to NPSD.
 - The new wrap should last 8-10 years and should be cleaned annually.
 - We would supply the art work, It would take a week to create the wrap, and then 2 days to actually wrap it.
 - Andrea Hinderliter made a motion to approve up to \$4500 to wrap the band trailer. Seconded by Dave Seibel. Unanimous vote yes! New, snazzy NPMK band trailer here we come!!!
 - Liz Overton asked if we can look into donations to help. John Ashley said we could possibly look into advertisers on the trailer.
 - Discussion about the logo and artwork for the side. We need to find out from NPSD if they create it or we can create it ourselves.
