#### **New Business**

- 2024 Considerations
  - Be sure to fill out the parent survey from Mr. Santanello. John Ashley will meet with Mr. S. to review the feedback and help make decisions for next vear.
  - The last two weeks of the season are pretty chaotic and we may make some changes to ease things up in the future.
    - Trunk or Treat will most likely not be necessary since NPMK does not have rehearsal on Halloween night any longer.

### **Indoor Programs Discussion**

- Indoor quard participation should be in the low 20s. The fee this year is \$350, plus a MANDATORY \$500 trip, plus an additional warm-up uniform for about \$150. Knights in need cannot be used for the trip. They may lose a few participants due to the \$1000 out-of-pocket cost.
- Indoor Percussion will also have about 20ish participants and has a \$485 fee. Sean Haddad is asking NPMA for an additional \$5000 for his IP budget. Our budget approved \$23,000 for IP based on the \$22,000 they spent last year. He asked for \$30,000 last year, but NPMA said no since we were still rebuilding our budget from Covid. Much of this additional money would be put towards staff pay. Percussion requires a lot of staff because each instrument requires a different specialist. The music writing is also costing them more this year because they had to use someone new to write it and they are more expensive. Finally, they would like to purchase better uniforms than last year. There will be an Indoor Percussion home show this year to bring in revenue which will hopefully offset some of this increase in budget.
- **Questions/Comments:** 
  - Julie Hanley asked about Indoor Guard and their budget. It is about \$12,000 and they have about 4 staff members.
  - WP has about 10 staff members and a \$23,000 budget. Parents think it should be more equal.
  - NPSD pays for the directors (Sean Haddad and Matt Hurley). They also pay for a floor each year that is supposed to alternate, but IP has taken it the last 3 years.
  - Indoor directors need to reach out to the board with what they need before the first week of November so we can incorporate it into the budget.
  - Mike Mooney made a motion to give \$5000 more to the IP program.
  - Andrea Hinderliter amended the motion to give \$2500 to both indoor groups. The \$2500 for Indoor Guard can be used to lower the cost of their trip.



- 23 votes in favor of the amended motion, 0 opposed. It's a unanimous decision to give \$2500 to each indoor program.
- This will reduce the trip cost by about \$125 for each indoor quard participant.
- Election of Dave Seibel as Co-Quartermaster
  - Greg Hinderliter nominated Dave Seibel for Co-Quartmaster, Andrea Hinderliter seconded. Unanimously voted yes. Welcome, Dave!
- As is custom, the December General Parent Meeting is Canceled. Next meeting will be Tuesday, January 16, 2024.
