#### **Unfinished Business**

- Knight of Sound October 5th
  - 18 bands signed up!
  - We will need many volunteers to help with that day.
    - Parking assistance is needed starting at 1:30 and throughout the day to direct buses and attendees.
    - Will also need security, they will prevent attendees from going into the stands while bands are performing.
    - Also need volunteers for 50/50 raffle
  - Show starts at 4. First awards will be at 6 and then a long intermission from 6:15-7:30.
  - Traveling trophies will only be given to Open class bands.
  - Former NP band director is donating money for the purpose of buying certificates and gift cards. Will be in the honor of an individual who drove the band many years ago.
